However, we would encourage those that are at risk to continue to participate in church virtually.

FACE COVERINGS <u>REQUIRED</u> FOR EVERYONE – Masks/bandanas required for all adults and children. We will have a few extras to give out if you don't already have one. Can anyone bring extra children's masks?

ADULT MUST ACCOMPANY CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES – If child needs to leave sanctuary, an adult must accompany them to ensure safe social distancing, hand washing and other safety behavior.

MAKE RESERVATIONS – We are setting up chairs in sanctuary to comply with social distancing.
